Supporting children who have experienced complex trauma comes with its own set of challenges. The wide-ranging harmful effects can disrupt many aspects of the child's development and can last well into adulthood. In this workshop, participants will have opportunities to explore case studies and engage in a 1-hour hands-on exercise to understand the Relational Learning Framework (RLF) for working with traumatised children. At the end of this workshop, participants will have a greater understanding of:

- Complex trauma and its effects on children's development (incl. attachment)
- Adverse childhood experiences (incl. maltreatment) and complex trauma
- Internal working models and the Relational Learning Framework (RLF)
- Intervention strategies and therapeutic techniques
- Practical strategies and techniques for effectively supporting children who have experienced trauma

Facilitator: Dr. Wendy Kelly (DipClinPsych, PhD)

Wendy has over 30 years of experience as a Clinical Psychologist working in the child protection and mental health fields and providing supervision, consultation and training to practitioners on child maltreatment and trauma. She has worked in a variety of settings including a sexual abuse counselling centre, Child, Youth and Family (now Oranga Tamariki, Ministry for Children) and a child and adolescent mental health service. Wendy has recently published a book 'Understanding children in foster care' after finishing her PhD on the topic in 2015.
